Hello Everyone

Welcome to church this morning. The latest government advice at the time of writing is that Trafford, and therefore our church, remains in an area of lockdown. The rise of COVID19 infections has meant that further restrictions on social gatherings have been imposed nationally.

However, those restrictions DO NOT apply to churches as the government does not view church as a 'social gathering' (they've clearly never visited St Margaret's!), therefore we can remain open, continue to meet and enjoy Holy Communion together.

Now that church is open we are changing our online services after today. Next weeks church service will be recorded and placed on YouTube and the website. We will be filming the service. Don't worry we will not be filming the congregation nor will we film the act of receiving Holy Communion, as this is a private moment between the individual and God. Hopefully, this change will bring more folk back to church but will also allow those who are on holiday or self-isolating to watch the service and feel part of something sacred.

As part of the preparations for opening church again we had to remove all the pew bibles. They presented a source of cross infection. This means that folk can't follow the epistle or Gospel readings during the service.

To overcome this we will be putting two sets of readings on the newsletter from here on. One set will be the readings for this Sunday (14th after Trinity), the other set will be for the following Sunday (15th after Trinity). The hope is that we can read the Gospel in advance of the Sunday service, we can then follow the readings in the service and have a little more idea about the nature of the sermon if we've read the Gospel prior to coming to church. Hopefully we will be affected by the Gospel when reading it at home rather than infected by reading it from a pew bible in church! You can of course bring your own bible to church to follow the lessons if you prefer.
